Details of this planned vaccination effort are still being determined. Initially, vaccine will be supplied in incremental allotments. However, ultimately sufficient vaccine will be available to saturate U.S. demand. The 7 regional districts would make requests to the state to gain access to the state stockpile in the event of an emergency.
