

# Creating an Equitable Vaccine System

## For People With Disabilities



### Vaccine Schedule Preferences

Make it easy for individuals to sign up for a time that works for their needs.

Individuals should be able to indicate an interest in receiving the vaccine **online**, along with their **preferred method of contact**.



### Vaccine Site Accessibility

States should look to establish:

1. **Mobile** vaccination programs;
2. **No-cost** transportation; and/or
3. **In-vehicle** vaccinations.



### Role of Community Organizations

State and local governments should adequately fund and collaborate with local healthcare organizations to **disseminate information** and help older adults and people with disabilities **schedule and access** their vaccines.



#### Local Resources:

- **Community Healthcare Centers (CHCs)** are local, affordable healthcare centers that help families get the care they need.
- The **2-1-1 System** is a phone number that will connect you to important community services. Trained call specialists answer calls 24 hours a day, every day of the year.
